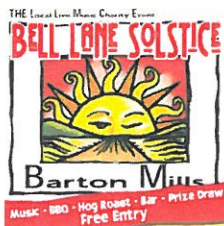

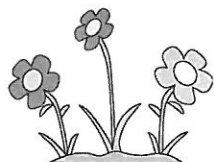

Even though I haven't heard it, a special visitor should have arrived in Barton Mills two months ago, well I hope it did! It's been coming, to MY knowledge, for over 75 years! Who or what is it, you ask – the Cuckoo! Sadly other sounds around us make it difficult for us to hear it unless we wake very early in the morning before the roads get too busy. As children it was always fun to be the first to hear it! The length of the cuckoo's stay is described in the following saying: *"April, I will; May, I stay; June, I change my tune and July, I fly!"*

The disciples I am sure were still reeling from past events, however, even though their Friend and Master had appeared to many of them after His death, **His work on earth was done and He had told them He was going to be with His Father in Heaven.** Jesus knew they would be very sad so **He promised them that when He left this earth He would send Someone else to be with them.** In John 16 v 7 we read, Jesus said **"If I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you"**. The word **"Helper" or "Comforter"** means **"called to one's side or aid"**, signifying that it is **Someone who can be to us what Christ was to His disciples.** Though He is invisible to our eyes, **the Holy Spirit is with us every day.** When I was a child it was always a difficult thing to understand how God could be everywhere, now I understand better the **Day of Pentecost**, this year on the 4th of June, when **He fulfilled this promise over 2000 years ago by replacing His bodily presence with the Holy Spirit.**

In contrast to the cuckoo, who every July leaves this country for warmer climes, in Hebrews 13 v 5, **God has promised never to leave us nor forsake us** and with the help of the Holy Spirit is there to **protect, comfort, encourage and counsel.** Let us rejoice as we remember Pentecost this year that **Jesus not only died, but rose from the grave, went back to His Father and is interceding for us right now, and best of all He is coming again!**

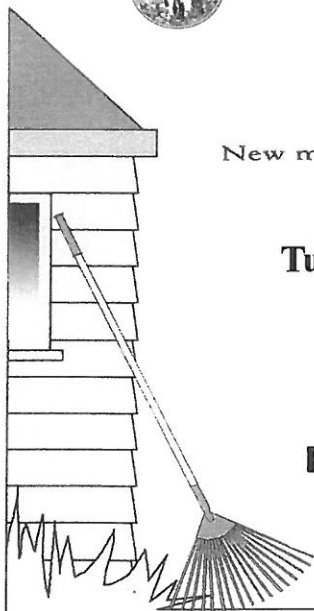

FOOTPATH TO MILDENHALL

The planned resurfacing work was delayed by the emergency gas works but, hopefully works will commence at the beginning of June.

SID SCHEME

The SID (Speed Indicator Device) equipment has now been erected, and the SID will be moved around sites in the village on a fortnightly basis. It is hoped this will help tackle the issue of speeding motorists through the village.

DEFIBRILLATOR

The adoption of the phone box is moving forward; the Council is currently liaising with BT regarding contracts. Once the phone box is handed over, the Council can move forward with purchasing and installing the Defibrillator.

STREET LIGHTING

The Parish Council has instructed Pearce & Kemp to carry out various maintenance and improvements to the street lighting in the village. This project is an ongoing one, and the Parish Council will be looking at other lights and areas of street lighting that need attention in the near future.
